



From Harrisburg, PA: Take US-22 north for 14.3 mi until it merges with US-11 N/US-15 N toward Selinsgrove/Williamsport. Travel 32.8 mi. Exit onto S US-11/US-15 and continue to follow US-15 35.8 miles. Make a slight left to merge onto I-180 and go 1.9 miles to exit 29 to merge onto US-15 N toward Mansfield. Go 46.7 miles and take the exit toward Wellsboro. Merge onto US-6/W Wellsboro St. Continue to follow US-6 for 54.9 miles into Coudersport. Once inside Coudersport follow signs for 44 West, two miles outside of town continue to follow 44 West as it makes a sharp left turn and Route 49 East continues straight. Follow 44 West for five miles and begin to look for Route 244 East. Take a hard right on to route 244 East and continue another three miles into the borough of Oswayo. Remain on 244 East as you exit Oswayo and proceed one mile and LE EK will be the light blue house on your left.

From Buffalo, NY: Take I-90 W toward Erie. Take exit 55 to merge onto US-219 S toward SPRINGVILLE/Orchard Park for 24.9 miles. Turn left at Collins Center Springville Rd/W Main St/NY-39/Rte-219/Rte-39/US-219. Continue to follow US-219 until you enter Pennsylvania. Go 8.3 miles and take the exit toward Kendall Ave/PA-46. Keep left at the fork, follow signs for the exit toward Kendall Ave/PA-46. Turn left at N Kendall Ave/Seaward Ave (signs for Smethport). Continue to follow N Kendall Ave for 6.5 miles. Continue on PA-46/ Rew Hill. Continue to follow PA-46 for 7.0 miles. Slight right to stay on PA-46 for 3.9 miles. Turn left at East St/PA-46/US-6. Continue to follow US-6 for 25.5 miles into Coudersport. Once inside Coudersport follow signs for 44 West, two miles outside of town continue to follow 44 West as it makes a sharp left turn and Route 49 East continues straight. Follow 44 West for five miles and begin to look for Route 244 East. Take a hard right on to route 244 East.
